

Election Committee Notes and Report November – 2013

Voting dates: October 30, 5-8pm and November 2, 10-4pm

Two locations used - Northside Library and Northwood/High Building

District 1 – One seat, no candidate or write in

District 2 - One seat, one candidate, no write in

District 3 – Two seats, one candidate, no write in

District 4 – Two seats, one candidate, no write in

Polling results: this was the first year that evening voting and the change of dates were used.

Northside Library –

October 30 - 11 voters

November 2 - 6 voters

Northwood/High –

October 30 - 2 voters

November 2 - 5 voters

Results: Voters by District

District 1 – 4 voters visited the polls

District 2 - 3 voters visited the polls

District 3 – 12 voters visited the polls

District 4 – 5 voters visited the polls

Election Results:

District 1 – no candidate

District 2 – Gena Shelton – 3 votes

District 3 – Jim Bach – 12 votes

District 4 – Ethan Hansen – 5 votes

Committee recommendations – a possible guide/outline for candidates to campaign, more flyers, a sample flyer for information for elections/polling locations for candidates, more notifications to neighborhood watch groups, organizations as the UAC database is built, look for better spots to let people know about elections. Educate the community about the change of year for UAC elections. A yearlong info/campaign to the public about UAC and what districts people live in through Community Relations committee. Also, committee recommends an emphasis on participation/help of Commissioners not running for seats during elections/polling.

Currently there are 3 vacant district seats in District 1, 3 and 4. These seats will announced but not be available until after the annual meeting in January after the winners of this election are approved by City Council and seated.
