**6:00 PM** – Business session for Zoning Committee. Meet at the Pride Center, 248 E. 11th Avenue.  
Potential topics to be discussed:

- *Review of agenda*

All applicants will be heard *after* the business session. Cases will be heard in the order as listed below. Applicants are requested to please bring **1** hard copy of the Variance Application plus **5** hard copies of:

- *List of variances being requested. Please make sure that all variances are correctly identified and noted.*
- *Statement of hardship identifying why variances are being requested.*
- *Plans/Site Plans.*
- *Photos & any other support materials to best present your case.*

**6:30PM** – Agenda items/cases will be listed below:

1. **White Castle site** – preliminary presentation of proposed mixed use development for the former White Castle site at Arcadia and High Streets. Applicant/presenter is David Vottero of Schooley-Caldwell Architects.
2. **1337-1345 Hunter Avenue** – variances for 2 properties on Hunter to turn two existing 2-family dwelling into two single family houses plus carriage houses. Presenter is Dave Perry..
3. **1503 & 1505 N. 4<sup>th</sup>** – proposed rezoning for 2 properties on N. 4<sup>th</sup> (*one lot is R-4; the other is C4*) to combine the lots into a single R-4 parcel for a proposed 3-family townhouse. Presenter is architect Julie Bullock.

Committee members will meet at the **Pride Center at 248 E. 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue**, unless otherwise directed. Parking is available but limited. Please enter the facility at the rear. The doors are always locked, but you may access the vestibule using the ADA push paddle. Once in the vestibule, press the buzzer to the right and someone will open the door. Please make sure that all variances are correctly identified and noted. There are 7 Zoning Committee members. As always, the public is welcome.

**PLEASE NOTE** that applicants that have received a vote at the Zoning Committee meeting will present at the next UAC meeting on **January 17, 2018**, where a vote will be taken by the entire Commission. An agenda for that meeting will be sent later. The results of the UAC vote and a written recommendation will be forwarded to the Columbus Board of Zoning Appeals (BZA), or City Council, or Graphics Commission, as appropriate to each applicant's case.
