- 1. Elected Chairperson
 - 1. Motion made by Doreen Uhas-Sauer and seconded by Steve Volkmann to nominate David Hegley as Chairperson.
 - Voting in the affirmative (Uhas-Sauer, Volkmann, Hegley, Frankhouser and Elbaor), Voting No: None. Motion
 passed unanimously.
- 2. Confirmed document with Commission member terms and plan to publish on Commission website
 - 1. All members agreed to the information Commissioner Volkmann put together
 - The final list will be sent out to the Commission and they will be offered a chance to include contact information along with the information already provided.
 - David Hegley will post the information to the Commission website
 - 2. There was some discussion on open seats
 - District 4 senate remains open
 - OSU Graduate student seat: There has been some discussion with Doreen by no name has been provided.
 - OSU Undergrad: There has been no communication from OSU Undergrad student government, Steve Volkmann will reach out to them
- 3. Reviewed plan for Commission training
 - 1. Discussed the planned bus tour of the University District
 - Doreen Uhas-Sauer reported the majority of survey responses were for a Saturday afternoon tour
 - It was decided to hold the bus tour in March after the Training planned for March 7.
 - At the next Commission meeting or via we mail Doreen will reach out to see what Saturday works best for all Commissioners.
 - 2. Decided the focus of the training will be zoning and the training session will be publicized as Demystifying Zoning: A Community Panel
 - 3. Confirmed we have agreement to do training during the Committee meetings on the first Wednesday in March.
 - We will have a Pot luck and encourage people to bring a dish to share, but pizza will be provided as a main course. Food set up can start as early as 5:30 PM
 - All Commissioners are strongly encouraged to attend this valuable training and the meeting like all Commission functions are open to the public.
 - 4. Confirmed there will be a panel discussion with University Area Zoning chair along with involvement of other Commission Zoning chairs or representatives from areas near the University Area.
 - 5. Proposed the following agenda items for the training session
 - Panel discussion on Zoning
 - Focus discussion on how Zoning impacts Area Commissions
 - Explain the differences between BZA and City Council for variances and how they impact Area Commissions.
 - Susan Keeny is confirming names of the speakers for the panel discussion, two of the names discussed
 - Chris Herman will speak about how Commissions can leverage their power on Zoning cases
 - Chad Gibson will explain the municipal side of the planning process.
- 4. Discussed topics Governance Committee should take up for the 2018 Commission year
 - 1. Carry over items from 2017 to be considered include:
 - Ways to better structure meetings to make sure schedule is met
 - Consideration of seating multiple members in a single elected seat to split the responsibilities over the term
 - Look at ways to further improve the efficiency of zoning presentations
 - Fix the bylaws to correct the name of Code Enforcement and Environment Committee
 - Consider bylaw change to assign specific requirements to look for code violations in the University Area
 - Work with the Election Committee to help simplify the election packet and process to complete the documents for community members running for election
 - Consider bylaw change to require all Commissioners take annual training
 - 2. New topics brought forward to the Committee:
 - Consider allowing Zoning to count as two being on two Committee meetings to fulfill the by law requirement that each Commissioner must sit on at least 2 Committees.
 - Consider dissolving Code Enforcement and moving that Committees responsibility under Planning Committee
 - Consider changing the requirements to sit on the Commission to allow people as young as 16 to run for and sit on the Commission.
 - Process to make sure we have the Election Committee in place per the bylaws
 - 3. A final agenda for the year will be finalized at the April Governance meeting.
