The following time limits will be adhered to for all zoning cases heard before the Commission:

Executive Committee Meeting - per presiding officer.

- 1. Zoning Committee presents the facts of the case 5 min. max
- Applicant Presentation 7 min. max.
- 3. Zoning Committee report 5 min. max
- 4. Public comment (max 3 people each pro/con) 2 min each (max). Only those who complete speaker slips prior to the case being heard will be considered for speaking based on the order the slips were received
- Commissioner discussion: Commissioner who wishes may speak once per round for 1 min (max) for 2 rounds. A Commissioner cannot save time for their second round or transfer their remaining time to someone
- 6. Applicant response 3 min (max)
- Commission vote.
